

### **Stewardship Love**

"I give you a new commandment: love one another. As I have loved you, so you also should love one another." (John 13:34)

"As I have loved you," this is the hard part for <u>Stewards</u> – Jesus's love is unconditional; our love usually comes with strings attached. It is easy to love someone when they love you back. But it takes mercy and compassion to love someone when you feel unappreciated, feel used or feel like your opinion doesn't matter. It takes courage and the grace of God to "love my neighbor" when they may be someone you don't like, someone you don't know, or someone that doesn't look like you.

### We have a Pope

We continue in this holy season of Easter to give praise and thanks to the Risen Lord. This is an Easter season we will not forget! The death of Pope Francis and the election of Pope Leo. As a parish community and under the patronage of St Augustine let us assure Pope Leo of our prayers and support in the days ahead. As an Augustinian parish we play a special part and have reason to rejoice! The Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops President, Bishop William McGrattan, called on the faithful to welcome the Pope and to "remember him daily in their prayers so that he may embark on his Petrine ministry with fidelity, confident that the Lord will help him." Pope Leo XIV has chosen a motto that reflects the Augustinian tradition: *In Illo uno unum*, which means "*In the One, we are one.*" The phrase is taken from Saint Augustine's *Exposition on Psalm 127*, where he explains that "although we Christians are many, in the one Christ we are one."

### Challenges remain with Euthanasia becoming 'normal' in Canada

In March 2025, the Bishops of Canada sent a letter to the Minister of Health with the following concern: The CCCB firmly opposes euthanasia and assisted suicide. They are an egregious violation of the inherent dignity and value of human life. The Catholic Church in Canada is deeply concerned by the rapid expansion of euthanasia, which has led our country to be the world's fastest-growing assisted dying jurisdiction and ranked second globally for "MAiD" deaths as a percentage of total deaths. I We strongly urge and implore the federal government to halt any further expansion of "MAiD" and focus instead on advancing compassionate, life-affirming palliative care.

Having just completed the annual week for Pro-Life causes; this subject remains a serious pastoral challenge at many levels. As I mentioned in my homilies, your power of attorney plays a critical role for your 'end of life' concerns. We live in a time where there is a culture of indifference (Pope Francis) and when it doesn't affect me personally "why should I react" or make a response. Yes in ALL Pro Life concerns.
