



Confession leads to healing and forgiveness



Different factors may keep one away; a previous confessor who was more harsh than merciful, infrequent opportunities at a local parish; a tendency to procrastinate; a lukewarm belief "am I really forgiven"? Come back to me with all your heart (prophet Joel). Come home to a loving Prodigal Father.

Inaugural mass ushers in the pontificate of Pope Leo XIV

He vowed last Sunday to work for unity and continuity, so that the Catholic Church becomes a symbol of peace in the world. Pope Leo spoke of his role as a Shepherd following in the steps of Peter, the Apostle. Beautiful weather greeted the thousands of pilgrims along with presidents, patriarchs and princes. May this special mass bring to fruition peace and justice in war torn areas, for example in Ukraine, Gaza, Nigeria and sadly many more.

A Bit of history

Interest has been shown in the history of our church, the stained-glass windows, the wood carvings, and how did we start? One of those main contributors was Wilfred Schwarzkogler. It is said that he commenced his work in 1956, months after the church was built in 1955. The interior of the church was enhanced by his talent in wood carvings, the altars, the Reconciliation Room, the stations of the cross and the small bronze pieces within the church. The top part of the ambo (lectern) features the shield of St Augustine. Wilfred shared his gifts and talents in the beauty of the Baptism font, with running water. Also, the side chapel houses the Blessed Sacrament, where many meditate before the Holy Eucharist and where Eucharist is brought to the sick daily, who are not able to be with us at mass. Wilfred shared his talent in many other churches as well, like my home parish of St Michael Corkery (near Carp) and also at St Maurice parish. Wilfred was responsible for building the flip up seats at St Maurice, that allow for easier maintenance. His bronze plaques which were commissioned by the federal government, can be seen across Canada.
