PASTOR'S DESK

MAY 26, 2024 – THE MOST HOLY TRINITY

Good Stewards

"The Spirit itself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God, and if children then heirs, heirs of God and joint heirs with Christ..." - ROMANS 8:16-17

If we are heirs to the kingdom of God, shouldn't we work to build up His kingdom? Shouldn't we be good <u>Stewards</u> of our inheritance, using our time in prayer, our talent in charitable works and our treasure to care for the Church that God has left to us? Our Church is a treasured heirloom from God. Do we treat it that way?

Most Holy Trinity is celebrated today:

Note the large carving of the Trinity above the altar. This is a clear reference to St Augustine's thesis and keen interest in the Blessed Trinity. St. Augustine centered his life on the Trinity, recognizing that God the Father creates with and through God the Son and God the Spirit. He attributed co-equal greatness to each divine person in the act of creation. For example, the greatness of the Father plus the greatness of the Holy Spirit equals the greatness of the Son. At the time of St Augustine, he was dealing a lot around heresy of Trinity, this Blessed time today. St Augustine was born Nov. 354 and died Aug. 28, 430.

Church funerals and weddings:

What is becoming more and more prevalent in obit notices? "At request of N., there will be no funeral service." The same goes for weddings taking place outside of the church. How is it going to be possible to reinstate the response of the faithful, to arrange Liturgies at church, at least in the short term and also for the future? Perhaps, it may be a question of cost. For both weddings and funerals, the church is the cheapest part of the day! We are seeing more family members not connected with the church or the faith that end up with either having just burial, or cremation, choosing to keep their loved one's cremated remains at home! **Note**, like at weddings, because of pastoral circumstance, there may be the choice of not having a mass, a Liturgy of the Word could be more appropriate.

CPR is life saving!

Did you know we have an AED unit located at the top of the stairs on the east side entrance of the church? What is an AED unit? AED, is an automated external defibrillator, used to help those experiencing sudden cardiac arrest. We are asking for volunteers with CPR training to seriously consider volunteering. We would ideally like to have someone available for each mass, who could respond in the event of a critical situation. We purchased this special unit about 6/7 years ago and thankfully it has never been used, but it is there for good reason. Please give this some prayerful thought.
