**Daily Quote from the Early Church Fathers**

*Eat Life - Drink Life, by Augustine of Hippo, 354-430 A.D. "'Unless you eat My Flesh and drink My Blood, you shall not have life in you,' says the Lord. Eat life - drink life. You will then have life, and life is complete. Then the Body and Blood of Christ will be life for each person under this condition: what is eaten visibly in the Sacrament be spiritually eaten and spiritually drunk in truth itself." (excerpt from Sermon 102,2)*

**WHO is listening?**

*Pope Leo XIV sent a message of support to participants at a Catholic university event marking 15 years since the abolition of the death penalty in his home state of Illinois. (April 24) Pope Leo affirmed the Catholic Church's teaching, which regards the death penalty as "inadmissible because it is an attack on the inviolability and dignity of the person". On the same day, the US administration announced plans to expand the available methods of federal execution, including bringing back the firing squad and the electric chair. ALL life issues from the womb to natural death is to be proclaimed! We are entering the month of May when all life issues are to be protected.*
