Stewardship in Relationship

"The Lord, a merciful and gracious God, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love and faithfulness. Exodus 34:6

Stewardship is the response to the goodness of God. We give out of gratitude to a gracious God, not out of fear that God will be vengeful.

Mass Explained

Standing posture 67. Standing, the fundamental posture of the Christian assembly, deserves special attention. It is the posture of a resurrection people, the respectful posture of a community that recognizes the presence of the risen Lord, a sign of reverence for the Gospel, a sign of the common action of offering praise and thanksgiving expressed in the Eucharistic Prayer, and the posture of the family that lives in intimate communion with the all-holy God. It is also the posture of the action of offering and the posture of those who make covenant with their God. Finally, it is the posture of openness to Jesus Christ and to one another in the Eucharistic assembly. *Note taken from Liturgical questions from CCCB (Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops).
