

Stewards Prayer

"...because I came down from heaven not to do my own will but the will of the one who sent me....'" JOHN 6:38 When Stewards pray the "Our Father", say the words slowly so you truly recognize what you are saying. Every day when praying this prayer, we repeat what Jesus said in the scripture passage — "thy kingdom come, thy will be done." Even though we say these words, do our actions reflect those words? This is the difference between saints and the rest of us. Saints were faithful and obedient to God's will. Start today — start aligning your words and actions with God's will for you.

Vigilance and Being Alert

In a world marked by instability, political polarization, violence and economic hardship, religious persecution is on the rise in scale and intensity, and Canada is not immune, says the latest report from the pontifical charity Aid to the Church in Need (ACN) (reports <u>Catholic register Oct. 21</u>). "Between 2021 and 2024, at least 44 churches in Canada were burned to the ground, with 24 confirmed as arson," the report said, these fires following unproven allegations of unmarked graves on the grounds of Indigenous residential schools.

Beyond the hour on Sunday:

In the face of today's challenges, we boldly commit ourselves to motivating, equipping and mobilizing Catholic communities around a common vision, so that our Church responds to the Mission received from the risen Lord to be **His witnesses to the end of the earth (Acts 1:8)**. With the power of the Holy Spirit, we will become a Church that goes out to help others know, love, and serve the Lord, goes deep in our relationship with Christ, and goes together in communion and faith. We continue to be instruments of bringing about the vision for our Diocese; that our Archbishop has inaugurated this past spring. In order to bring this about, each one of us by our Baptism has a responsibility!
