PASTOR'S DESK

OCTOBER 20, 2024 - 29TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Stewardship Service

"For the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve and to give his life as a ransom for many." (Mark 10:45)

If you held a mirror up to your life, would it reflect God's love and mercy? If you are struggling with this, try changing your attitude from "I want more" to "thank you God for everything you have given me, I have enough to share". This change to Stewardship will bring you joy through service to others. Pray daily to become less self-centered and to become more God-centered.

The Synod on Synodality, is a good opportunity to reiterate the centrality of those who suffer most from violence and poverty. The spirit of the Synod in Rome (month of October) is one of listening to the Holy Spirit. The greatest decision to be made is that the Church, through the Synod, be a messenger of living together, of respect for the other, and of the need to free ourselves from the fear of the other ... to learn from our brothers and sisters of other countries and nationalities. The Church needs to move away from centrist ideology of European model or North American ideals (a move) to the south where the Church is vibrant and alive in Evangelization and Joy of the Gospel. Great reference to the Holy Father's visit to south/east Asia, what a 'wake up call ' to the whole world, with a very alive, vibrant church! Where do you stand and reflect on your role as a Baptized believer; follower of Jesus; in view of the recent Synod and going forward as a Synodal church? (Fr Frank)

Prayer is an essential part of the Gospel story

When Jesus made major decisions, when we ourselves seek prayers, or when we are asked to pray for other people's intentions, or for those who are ill, is our approach to prayer with joy and confidence?

Weekday homily reference (Fr Frank)

What does Jesus' prayer tell us about God and about ourselves? First, it tells us that God is both Father in being the Creator and Author of all that he has made, the first origin of everything and transcendent authority, and he is eternally Father by his relationship to his only Son who, we can approach God confidently as a Father who loves us:

Father in heaven, you have given me a mind to know you, a will to serve you, and a heart to love you. Give me today the grace and strength to embrace your holy will and fill my heart with your love that all my intentions and actions may be pleasing to you. Help me to be kind and forgiving towards my neighbor as you have been towards me. Amen.
