PASTOR'S DESK

Humble Stewardship

"...for whoever exalts himself will be humbled, and the one who humbles himself will be exalted." LUKE 18:14
Pride and ego are the root causes of most of our sins. Thinking your time is so valuable or your talent is better than anyone else or your money gives you status is another way of making those things "gods" before God. Pride is the opposite of humility. Remember stewardship. All that we have and all that we are is a gift from God. We should be humbled by God's incredible generosity and be grateful for all we have been given. Ultimately, gratitude leads us to humility.

Rising Vigilance

Fear and vigilance rise as attacks on houses of worship intensify worldwide. This seems to be the headlines now on our worship spaces. No question, we do not remain complacent. I had the experience in my previous parish of St. Martin de Porres in Bells Corners, back in May 2014, when attackers came in like a "thief in the night," with the highlight of taking the Tabernacle out of the church (among other brazen things). Just last year once again this parish was hit with vandalism (from outside) and windows were smashed not once but two times more! No question that every week hundreds of millions of people around the world gather to worship in peace. But for some, there comes a day when deadly violence invades their sacred spaces and our sense of innocence is gone.

Beyond the Hour on Sunday

As we approach the end of the liturgical year at the end of November, the thought occurred to me that we are in challenging times in celebrating Sacraments. You may be surprised to know that we had only nine church funerals, six baptisms (to date) and only one wedding and one marriage convalidation this year. What does this tell us? This seems to be a trend that is happening in several parishes. We are still accepting registration for children for the Initiation Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and/or Eucharist.
