PASTOR'S DESK

Stewardship Self-Control

"For God did not give us a spirit of cowardice but rather of power and love and self-control." 2 TIMOTHY 1:7

Many of us compartmentalize our faith, we bring it out only when we attend Mass or when we attend a parish event. Being a good steward requires discipline and striving to put God first in everything - all the time. The next time you are at a neighborhood party or at work or out shopping, would your words and actions signal to others that you are a good and faithful servant of our Lord?

Daily mass reflection (taken from Fr. Frank's homily on Wednesday, Sept. 24th):

Did you ever wonder about the amazement and importance of our Baptism?

Think of those who give witness to the Word of God in their life. A couple of weeks ago on Sept. 7 we had the canonization of Carlos Acutis (B. May 3, 1991, D. 11 Oct. 2006, age 16) and Giorgio Frassati (B. April, 6 1901, D. July 4, 1925, age 24), both laymen giving witness to the Gospel. They took this question very seriously: What kind of power and authority does God want you to exercise in your personal life and service? God's word has power to change and transform our lives. Jesus gave his apostles both power and authority to speak and to act in his name - to cast out evil spirits, to heal, and to speak the word of God. When Jesus spoke of power and authority he did something unheard of. He wed power and authority with love and humility. The world and the flesh seek power for selfish gain. Jesus teaches us to use it for the good of our neighbor.

Pray the Rosary:

Pope Leo XIV invites the faithful to join in praying the Rosary every day during October to invoke God's gift of peace and announces a rosary in St. Peter's Square on October 11 as part of the Jubilee of Marian Spirituality. I would ask those who communally pray the rosary here after Mass, to offer this for peace in Middle East. Catholics across the globe will unite to pray the rosary for peace in war-torn lands, especially during the month of October, which the Church dedicates to the Holy Rosary.
