

This week we return to the liturgical season of Ordinary Time. This Sunday and next Sunday, however, are designated solemnities. special days that call our attention to central mysteries of our faith.

Today, on the first Sunday after Pentecost, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. This feast invites us to consider what we believe about God, who has revealed himself to us in the Trinity—one God in three persons.

The verses of today's Gospel come near the end of Jesus' long discourse at the Last Supper. In the early part of this discourse, as we saw last week on Pentecost, Jesus offers assurances to the disciples. Even though he must leave the disciples, he tells them that they will have a future because of the help he will send them in the Holy Spirit. In this section he focuses more on the shape of the future, which will include Jesus' victory over the world that they will share in. The disciples of Jesus cannot know the future. They can only know that whatever shape the future takes, they will not have to face it alone. They have the Spirit of Truth, who will continue to provide the teaching of Jesus in the future.

Reading this passage on Trinity Sunday reinforces our understanding of the unity shared by the members of the Trinity. Although the idea of one God in three persons remains a mystery, we have the assurance that, as Jesus and the Father share all, Jesus and the Spirit share all. (Loyola Press)

KENYA BUILD 2025 - Our Lady of Lourdes parish has been a long-time supporter of the School Sisters of Notre Dame - Province of Africa and their work in Nyalieng'a Kenya. The last two visitors from Africa, Sister Oyin-oza (2023) and Sister Masicha (2024) provided information not only about the Notre Dame Children Outreach program but also about the construction of the Blessed Theresa Gerhardinger Educational Centre. The construction of the Elementary School - Phase 1 is proceeding well but additional funds are urgently needed to complete the structure before classes start in January 2026. MOST HOLY TRINITY

Since the development of the devotion to the Sacred Heart in France in the 17th century, the month of June has been connected to the Sacred Heart. Thus, it was probably in June or July 1674, that St. Margaret Alacoque received a message from Jesus requesting to be honoured under the figure of his heart, also saying that, when he appeared radiant with love, he asked for a devotion of expiatory love: frequent reception of Communion,



especially on the first Friday of the month, and the observance of the Holy hour.

Again, during the octave of Corpus Christi in 1675, probably on June 16, the vision known as the "great apparition" took place and asked Margaret Mary for a feast of reparation of the Friday after the octave of Corpus Christi. While Pope Clement XIII had officially instituted the feast of the Sacred Heart for some places on February 6, 1765, the feast was extended to the whole church when Pope Pius IX in 1856, designated the Friday following the octave of the feast of Corpus Christi as the feast of the Sacred Heart. During the Second Vatican Council to fully dedicate that month to this specific devotion, the feast was raised to the rank of a solemnity.

On 5 June 1965, Pope Paul VI called for a renewal of the devotion to the Sacred Heart. And, in 1995, Saint John Paul II reiterated the importance of this devotion and instituted the World Day of Prayer for the Sanctification of Priests on the feast of the Sacred Heart in June so that "the priesthood might be protected in the hands of Jesus, rather in his heart, so it could be open to everyone." During this month of June, we are reminded of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, to call to mind Christ's love for us, which is visible in a special way in the image of His pierced heart, and we pray that our own hearts might be conformed to His, calling us to love and respect all His people.

Mass for the feast of the Sacred Heart will be celebrated on June 27th. at 8:30 am., followed by devotions to the Sacred Heart and benediction of the Blessed Sacrament.



Congratulations to all the youth of our parish who were confirmed in the Holy Spirit this week. May you use your gifts wisely to be true disciples of the Lord.
