We begin the season of Lent this week on Ash Wednesday. We will celebrate Mass with the distributions of Ashes at 9am and 7pm. Please note that Ash Wednesday is a day of fast and abstinence.

On Fridays during Lent, we will have Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament at 6:00pm with Benediction at 6:45. Confessions will be heard during Adoration. Next weekend, they will be enrolled in the Book of the Elect at the Cathedral during the Rite of Election. As a parish, we'll have a chance to welcome then on the 3rd, 4th, and 5th Sundays of Lent as they come for the scrutiny prayers during the weekend Masses.
