## TRINITY SUNDAY

For many Christians, the Holy Trinity may have best been expressed by a Russian Orthodox monk and icon painter named Andrei Rublev in 1411, over a thousand years ago. Rublev painted an icon that shows 3 figures gathered round a table. They are angels who represent the Father, the Son, & the Holy Spirit. Sitting on the table at the front, closest to the viewer, is a dish of food & a space in front of it for the viewer to join the 3 figures at the table, to eat with them, to *join them in the life they share. That vacant place is meant to convey openness, hospitality, and welcome towards any human being who will join them. That place is meant for each of us. It means that God wants to share his very life with us. It asks us to allow ourselves to be enveloped in the transforming love that God, in these three persons, has for us. In experiencing God as the Father who created us and our world; as the Son who redeems us from sin with a sacrificial love that takes one's breath away; and as the Spirit who comforts & guides us along our pilgrimage through life, we will inevitably find ourselves impelled towards responding: we are led to ask 'How do we pour ourselves out in love, the way our God does? How do we become signs of the transforming love God has for us? How do we become GIFTS of something greater. for others.'* The invitation of Rublev's Holy Trinity icon is to become part of the life of the Trinity itself. It is probably impossible to overstate how transforming that is.
