# THE 150TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE DEATH OF BISHOP JOHN FARRELL,

First Bishop of Hamilton is marked next Tuesday, September 26th. He died in 1873 at the age of 53. Among other pastoral efforts, Bishop Farrell was dedicated to building a strong Catholic school system. By the end of his tenure, twenty-six Catholic schools had been established in the Diocese of Hamilton. The first Catholic library in Hamilton was opened under Bishop Farrell in 1858, just two years after the establishment of the Diocese!
