

## From the Pastor's desk:

#### Jesus is risen alleluia!

Since the corona virus hit the world with a rage, the word "unprecedented" has often been used. We are in an unprecedented time. There have been other times in the history of mankind when terrible events have occurred, but for those of us alive now, this time is unprecedented. As I type this message there seems to be no end to the pandemic in sight. 


