#### **Canonization of Blessed Carlo Acutis**

Blessed Carlo Acutis will be the first millennial saint to be canonized by Pope Francis during the Jubilee Mass for teenagers from St. Peter's Square in Rome on Sunday, April 27, 2025, 4:30 am ET. Later, on Sunday, August 3, 2025, Pier Giorgio Frassati will be canonized. These were two very young men who lived exemplary lives and stood up for Christ.
