Serra Club Writing & Song Contest Presentations:



Chalice parish sponsorship weekend is coming, May 11 and 12.

Chalice is the largest Catholic sponsorship organization in Canada. Chalice has an "A" rating and is ranked in the Charity Intelligence Top 100 charities with 90.2% of all donation dollars go to support programs. Its president is a catholic priest Fr. Pat Cosgrove, who lives in Nova Scotia. Information on Chalice can be found at www.chalice.ca.

Last year, Chalice sponsored almost 50,000 children in 13 countries and served over 3.8 million meals. Chalice could not have done it without the efforts of all those who live the Gospel message: - to give food to the hungry, to give drink to the thirsty, to cloth the naked, to invite the stranger. It is in the efforts of all the sponsors across Canada that Chalice's mission continues: to reveal God's love in action by serving the poor. Children are enrolled for sponsorship based on need and family circumstances, regardless of race, age, ability, gender, or religion. The sponsored child receives all the support they need (nourishment, clean water, medicine) so they can finish school and that support comes from the ongoing sponsorships.

As a sponsor you will receive correspondence from your child every year. This will include a new photo, a letter from your sponsor child and a status report from a Field Worker. You will also receive a Christmas card along with a sponsor site update from the Site Director. But the one thing that you will receive as a sponsor, that is greater and more important than anything else, is knowing that by your sponsorship of a child in need, through Chalice, you will forever have changed that child's life, for the better.

You will have an opportunity to sponsor a child in need, through Chalice, after each Mass on May 11 and 12. Volunteers from Chalice will be at the back of the church to help you choose your sponsor child and sign up for sponsorship. 58 children will be waiting for someone to sponsor them on that weekend. Please pray about sponsoring a child and if you already are a sponsor, are you being called to sponsor another?

If you can't sponsor a child at this time, donations of any amount can be made to Chalice to further its work in sponsoring needy children around the world. Charitable Tax Receipts are issued for the full amount of your sponsorship.

Come to the back of the church on May 11 and 12 after each mass and see the faces of these beautiful children that need you, to sponsor them.
