Also, it is preferable to use the shorter version of the alleluia for those who do sing. Also, remember to not move the ribbons in the lectionary during the weekend Masses.

Prevent MAiD for Mental Illness - Support Bill C-218
In March 2021, Canada expanded its euthanasia law (Bill C-7) to allow MAiD for mental illness alone, with implementation delayed until March 17, 2027. To stop this change, MP Tamara Jansen introduced Bill C-218 on June 20, 2025. If passed, Bill C-218 will exclude mental illness from being considered a "grievous and irremediable medical condition," preventing MAiD for mental illness alone.
