## Archdiocese News

### Prevent MAiD for Mental Illness - Support Bill C-218

In March 2021, Canada expanded its euthanasia law (Bill C-7) to allow MAiD for mental illness alone, with implementation delayed until March 17, 2027. To stop this change, MP Tamara Jansen introduced Bill C-218 on June 20, 2025. If passed, Bill C-218 will exclude mental illness from being considered a "grievous and irremediable medical condition," preventing MAiD for mental illness alone. The bill's first debate occurred on December 5, and a second debate and vote are scheduled for February 2026. Support Bill C-218 by signing the petition here:
