Modesty in Dress Attire

Every year about this time we remind folks of the fact that we as Christians are "in the world, but not of the world". This pertains to every aspect of our lives, from the political party for whom we vote, our stance on protecting life in all of its phases, our call to stewardship of time, talent & finances, as well as the way in which we cover "the temple of the Holy Spirit" which is our bodies. The secular world is highly sexualized and not least in the so-called fashions of the day. Young men want to direct attention to their bottoms by letting their pants fall as low as they possibly can without falling off, shifting their pants upwards every few seconds or holding them with one hand and walking as if they just had an accident in their pants. Many girls and young women have never been taught that their bodies are sacred and are to be covered as we cover anything that is a treasure. In other words, Christians should never dress suggestively and certainly not when they attend the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass.

Canonization of Blessed Carlo Acutis

Blessed Carlo Acutis will be the first millennial saint to be canonized by Pope Leo from St. Peter's Square in Rome on Sunday, September 7, 2025 along with Pier Giorgio Frassati. Mrs. Normandeau will deliver a presentation in French, with an English translation, on Saturday, September 27, at 1:30 PM at St. Boniface Cathedral.
