From the Pastor's desk

Summer Mass time schedule

In the past, we changed the mass time to 8:00am Monday to Friday in July and August. This year, we will be keeping the mass time at 9am.

Weddings

The protocol for marriages here at St. Anthony's Parish begins with registration. In registering one signifies that he/she wants to become an active member of this parish. A registration form can be obtained from the parish office. In registering a person also commits him/herself to contributing to the financial needs of the parish. We remember that we give the "cream of the crop" to the Lord and not what is left over. The Biblical amount is 10%. One must be registered for at least one year prior to the wedding. Marriage preparation is a requirement in all Catholic parishes within the Archdiocese of Winnipeg. We want couples to be committed to Christ and to the parish and not simply to use the parish as a vehicle for their immediate want. If a person is over the age of 18 and working, then they no longer come under the umbrella of their parents. Much time is often spent in preparing a couple for marriage, only to have them disappear following the wedding. Some become immediate lapsed Catholics and others attend another parish, which makes one question why they didn't get married in that other parish to begin with. Many would-be couples are not evangelized, so besides preparing them for a life-long marriage, we try and get them to commit to Christ. All of this requires time and patience. We repeat this announcement often because we continue to receive requests for weddings here at St. Anthony's simply because, they tell us, that we have a beautiful church.

Change in Collection

Periodically I need to remind folks not to place nickels, dimes and quarters in the collection. The reason is that it often takes the counters a long time to count and roll these coins. We are to be good stewards of what God has given to us. This means that we give God the best, not the "left overs" or that which we simply want to get rid of. When we joyfully give to God one-tenth of what He has given to us, He blesses us by giving us even more. On the other hand, there is no blessing for the miserly.


