From the Pastor's desk

Discerners' Italy Pilgrimage

Many people have been asking how our pilgrimage to Italy went. I think that I am speaking for the 14 of us who went to Italy, by saying that our pilgrimage was awesome. I sensed the presence of God from the moment we left Winnipeg. He guided us along the way from Rome to Assisi to Bassano to Padua to Venice and safely back to Winnipeg. Our flights were on time & without incident. No one had any health problems, no one got lost and no one got robbed. We had good accommodations in both Rome where we stayed with the Consolata Missionaries who are about one block from the Vatican and at the Scalabrini Monastery in Bassano, which is near Venice. We began each day with Morning Prayer and Holy Mass. We four priests: Father Oliver Omega, Fr. Christopher Dubois, Fr. Peter Nemcek and Fr. Dominic Yuen celebrated Mass at St. Peter's Basilica in the Vatican together with the discerners and there were chapels where we celebrated Mass in both the Consolata and Scalabrini Monasteries. There were several places where I sensed the nearness of God and the respective saints who rested there. For me, St. Carlo Acutis in Assisi was the highlight of our pilgrimage. Although he is dead for many years now, his body is incorrupt, encased in a glass sarcophagus. He appears to be asleep in his blue jeans and jacket. I want to thank the many individuals who gifted money to assist in this pilgrimage, including the parents of several of the discerners. The Archdiocese contributed 50% of the entire trip for the discerners and it would appear that the gifts from various parishioners will cover the rest. Thank you to all who prayed, especially for the discerners while we were on our pilgrimage. We will leave the rest between God and the discerners in terms of seeking first the Kingdom of God and his righteousness.
