From the Pastor's desk

All Souls Day This year the first Sunday in the month of November begins with All Souls Day. We remember all those individuals who have died in good standing with the Lord. They may be doing some time in purgatory to be cleansed of any venial sins, but the good news is that eventually they will make it into the heavenly courts of the blessed. St. Faustina informed us that the souls in purgatory told her that the greatest torment that they had was a longing for God. Jesus told her "my mercy does not want this, but justice demands it." We remember the dead in a particular way during the month of November. We pray for them as we are told in 2 Maccabees 12: 44 & 45 and we make atonement for them as did Judas. We also continue to honor our parents in death by praying and gaining indulgences on their behalf. We offer Masses for them and pray that they soon be released from their suffering.

The Discernment Group consists of approximately twelve young men who meet every month. The young men may not all advance to become priests, but it is certainly our hope and prayer that some will. The primary goal of the group is to build their relationship with God, the Church and one another, so that, no matter what vocation they may choose, they may be more rooted in their Catholic faith. We begin our time together with Eucharistic Adoration, followed by pizza. We then have a talk on a particular subject like: prayer, stewardship, confession, purity or other relevant topics. Sometimes we have a guest, such as another priest or lay person who speaks on a given subject. Other times we watch a video, followed by a discussion. We end the evening in the church with the Chaplet of Divine Mercy. We also attend events in the Archdiocese such as Pro-life suppers, Chrism Mass, ordinations or the annual Serra supper.. There are many who pray and sacrifice for these young men, in particular those who attend Eucharistic adoration in the Adoration Chapel. We are grateful for their intercessory prayers, as well as any others who may be praying for vocations to the priesthood and to the religious life.
