MARRIAGE: Contact the parish office 6 months or more before marriage. Marriage Preparation is mandatory in the Archdiocese of Winnipeg.



The Discernment Group consists of approximately twelve young men who meet every month. The young men may not all advance to become priests, but it is certainly our hope and prayer that some will. The primary goal of the group is to build their relationship with God, the Church and one another, so that, no matter what vocation they may choose, they may be more rooted in their Catholic faith. We begin our time together with Eucharistic Adoration, followed by pizza. We then have a talk on a particular subject like: prayer, stewardship, confession, purity or other relevant topics. Sometimes we have a guest, such as another priest or lay person who speaks on a given subject. Other times we watch a video, followed by a discussion. We end the evening in the church with the Chaplet of Divine Mercy. We also attend events in the Archdiocese such as Pro-life suppers, Chrism Mass, ordinations or the annual Serra supper.. There are many who pray and sacrifice for these young men, in particular those who attend Eucharistic adoration in the Adoration Chapel. We are grateful for their intercessory prayers, as well as any others who may be praying for vocations to the priesthood and to the religious life.

Free Masons Catholics are forbidden to become Free Masons or even to be associated with them. The principles of Masonic associations are irreconcilable with the doctrine of the Church. The faithful who enroll in Masonic associations are in a state of grave or mortal sin and **may not** receive Holy Communion. Although Free Masons claim that they are simply a fraternity, the fact remains that religious error is error, no matter what the context. Free Masons reject the Catholic Church's teaching that there is only one God, the Blessed Trinity; and that Jesus Christ is the one way of salvation. Free Masons also deliberately omit Christ from its dogma of bodily resurrection, its teachings on resurrection are heretical because they are contrary to divine revelation taught by the Catholic Church. Catholics objectively commit the sin of heresy by swearing oaths to adhere to heretical teachings. By committing heresy, a Catholic commits a mortal sin and loses the life of Sanctifying Grace, placing himself under God's condemnation. To be free from the slavery to Free Masonry one must first renounce his Masonic membership by confessing it in the Sacrament of Penance. The Catholic must also confess the sins which he committed by swearing Masonic oaths. The Masonic self-curses sworn on the Holy Scriptures, exacerbate the gravity of the sin. The self curses could potentially carry with them attendant spiritual evils from which deliverance is necessary. Second, the Catholic should write a letter of resignation to the lodge in which he was initiated. Most lodges will read the letter out loud to its members. This stands as a witness to other Catholics who are involved in Free Masonry. This also applies to affiliated groups: Shriners, Order of the Eastern Star for women, DeMolay for boys, Job's Daughters for girls and any other group which espouses Masonic ideology.
