Finance Council and PPC meeting

The Finance Council will meet at 6:30 pm and PPC will meet at 7:30 pm on [Wednesday](#), 12 November. Our usual day to meet would have been the day before, that is 11 November, however that is Remembrance Day.

Mission Month

October is mission month. We remember our mandate to "spread the Good News", that is, by virtue of our baptism, to evangelize. In a particular way there are those who go to distant and some not-so-distant places to tell others about Jesus. Our Holy Father Pope Leo XIV was a missionary in Peru for twelve years, so he has a special interest in the missionary activity of the Church. The day after his inauguration as pope, at Mass he said "There are many settings in which the Christian faith is considered absurd, meant for the weak and unintelligent; settings where other securities are preferred, like technology, money, success, power, or pleasure. It is not easy to preach the Gospel and bear witness to the truth, where believers are mocked, opposed, despised, or at best tolerated and pitied. Yet these are precisely the places where the missionary outreach of the Church is desperately needed." The [third Sunday in October \(19 Oct.\)](#) is always Mission [Sunday](#). A world wide collection is taken up in every parish, regardless of how rich or poor. The collection goes to the Society for the Propagation of the Faith to be distributed to those territories in the world who are in need: training of seminarians, support of catechists, pastoral care, healthcare and more. Cheques can be made out to your parish with an indication that it is to be directed toward Mission [Sunday](#).

October: pray the rosary & prayer to St. Michael

October is traditionally the month when we pray the rosary in a more dedicated fashion. We ask Mary and St. Michael Archangel to protect the Church from the devil, who always seeks to separate us from God and from each other.

The Discernment Group consists of approximately twelve young men who meet every month. The young men may not all advance to become priests, but it is certainly our hope and prayer that some will. The primary goal of the group is to build their relationship with God, the Church and one another, so that, no matter what vocation they may choose, they may be more rooted in their Catholic faith. We begin our time together with Eucharistic Adoration, followed by pizza. We then have a talk on a particular subject like: prayer, stewardship, confession, purity or other relevant topics. Sometimes we have a guest, such as another priest or lay person who speaks on a given subject. Other times we watch a video, followed by a discussion. We end the evening in the church with the Chaplet of Divine Mercy. We also attend events in the Archdiocese such as Pro-life suppers, Chrism Mass, ordinations or the annual Serra supper. There are many who pray and sacrifice for these young men, in particular those who attend Eucharistic adoration in the Adoration Chapel. We are grateful for their intercessory prayers, as well as any others who may be praying for vocations to the priesthood and to the religious life.
