Bells

Many people have mentioned to me that they are happy to hear the bells in our belfry. The one bell which was in the original St. Anthony Church was returned to the parish by [redacted]. The other bell came to us from the Sisters of the Good Shepherd before they left Marymount. Usually when bells are cast for a certain location, they harmonize. Our bells were made for two different locations, thus their harmony is not tuned. The bells ring the Angelus daily at 12 noon and 6 pm. They also ring prior to the [Saturday](#), 4 pm Mass and the [Sunday](#) 11 am Mass. A big **Thank You** to those who contributed to the bell fund. the bells are one of the memorials of our 100th Anniversary during the Jubilee Year.
