

#### From The Pastors Desk...

And once more, I say: Happy Easter! Bonne fête de Pâques! Maligayang pasko ng Pagkabuhay! Buona Pasqua! ¡Felices Pascuas de la Resurrección! Wesolych Świąt Wielkanocnych! Ezi Ista!! أفصح سعيد No matter what the language, as Church we arrive yet again at the celebration of our raison d'être: Christ is risen. He is truly risen! Alleluia!

When we look back at our world since last Easter, so much has happened. People have been shot. Terrorism continues in the world. More refugees are created. In the states there have been gun massacres in schools and hotels. The Canadian government is asking anyone receiving funding for summer jobs to certify that they support certain behaviours that go against Church teaching. People get sick. They lose their jobs. They die. There is so much wrong with the world.

Yet at the same time, good things happen. People who suffer all kinds of persecution in their home countries come here and begin a new life. Recently in Washington around 800,000 young people rallied for gun control in the US. Medical breakthroughs are happening. Life is being born!

When Jesus was killed, his followers thought it was the worst possible thing that could happen. Their hero, the guy they thought might be the Messiah, the man who would free them from Roman occupation, was put to death. Jesus' followers went back to fishing or whatever their occupations were. But then Christ rose from death to new life, and brought new life to all! God's final word is not death; it is life. No matter what goes wrong in the world and in our lives, that is not God's final answer; instead, the final answer is life, something more than we could imagine. When the eyes of our heart are open, we can see God's life springing up in so many unexpected places. My promise this Easter season is to see the newness of life that God is offering. Won't you join me?
