From the Administrator's Desk...

I have always loved the story of the disciples on the road to Emmaus. It has always been one of my favourite post-Resurrection appearances, perhaps because it speaks so powerfully to us about how our lives change when we truly encounter Christ, just as the disciples recognized him in the breaking of the bread.

The emotions in this story are palpable- one can almost feel how heavy the disciple's footsteps are as they walk down the road, questioning everything they had believed about Jesus. Even the news about the empty tomb wasn't enough to shake their doubts. It is in the midst of this doubt and sadness that Jesus appears, and walks with these two disciples on their journey.

Although the disciples do not recognize Jesus, he resumes the role of teacher, and opens their minds to understand the scriptures, and to understand why the events of the past few days have taken place. Jesus helps them to see why he had to suffer, so that he could enter into his glory. And then, to show that it was all true, he breaks bread with the disciples- and in that moment, they recognize him for who he is. And although he vanishes from their sight, their hearts are now on fire with the good news of the resurrection- so much so that they run the 11 kilometers back to Jerusalem to share the good news with the other disciples. To put that into perspective: If you were to start at the Ambassador Bridge, and head east along Riverside Drive, 11 kilometers is somewhere in the vicinity of Lauzon Road. That's quite a distance to run, especially right after having just walked it during the day!

So what can we take away from this story? First, I think it teaches us the importance of accompanying others on their journey, especially in the midst of their sufferings and difficulties. We may not always have the right words to say, as Jesus did, but even our presence can be a powerful support to others in a time of need. The second takeaway is the importance of sharing what God has done for us with others. When the disciples realized that they had encountered the risen Lord, they could not keep that news to themselves. We, who encounter the Lord each time we receive the Eucharist, are also called to share the good news of what He has done for us with those we meet. That is part of our mission as disciples of Christ. As we journey throughout this week, my prayer is that we all recognize our call to share the Good News of the Gospel with all that we meet.


