Second Sunday of Easter—April 28th, 2019

From the Pastor's Desk...

Alleluia! He is risen, and he is merciful! On this weekend as we celebrate the end of the Octave of Easter and Divine Mercy Sunday, I am challenged to live the values of resurrection and mercy in my own life—and I am reminded of how far I am from reaching that goal at times. This weekend we hear in the Acts of the Apostles: "A great number of people would also gather from the towns around Jerusalem, bringing the sick and those tormented by unclean spirits, and they were all cured." And in the Gospel passage, Jesus breathes on the disciples and says, "Receive the Holy Spirit. If you forgive the sins of any, they are forgiven them;..." In the bible, the forgiveness of sins and physical healing were closely related. So, in a sense, Luke is telling us in the Acts of the Apostles that the disciples forgave the sins of all those sick and tormented by unclean spirits! He doesn't even mention whether they were repentant or notthey are just cured!

As we continue our series called "Groundbreaking", we are reminded that the early Church broke new ground by being messengers of forgiveness and healing in the world. They recognized that with the Holy Spirit they were called to be God's healing and merciful presence. Our task is the same: we are to be on the lookout for the hurting in the world and be a source of healing. I know I can't go to Sri Lanka and be with the Christians who were wounded there or who lost family members in the tragic bombings on Easter Sunday, but I don't have to do that in order to help those who are hurting. All I have to do is open my eyes and my heart to what is around me, right here in Windsor. What's going on here may be less dramatic, but it doesn't mean that there is less need. Just being present, and listening to someone can be a powerful healing act.

We here at Assumption parish are also breaking new ground. I'm excited at the Windsor community's initial response to our roofing campaign. Just in the first weekend we received over \$6000 in donations for shingles. It will be an honour to see the names of so many people on the backs of the shingles as the historic church is re-roofed, protecting the building from further deterioration. Invite friends and family to participate as we break new ground in our parish's history.


