From the Administrator's Desk...

This Sunday, the church celebrates what is known as "Good Shepherd Sunday." This Sunday is so named because our Gospel reading is taken from the 10th Chapter of John's Gospel, known as the Good Shepherd discourse. In this passage, Jesus uses several images related to shepherding to show his relationship to us, his flock. He reminds us that we are called to listen to his voice, and to follow him when he calls to us. He also reminds us that he is the gate for the sheep, which leads to eternal life. This is the "abundant life" that Jesus refers to at the end of today's Gospel.

In a day and age when there are so many voices clamouring for our attention, it can be difficult to hear the voice of Jesus speaking to us. Our challenge is to learn to "tune out" the noise of the world, so that we can hear the voice of the Saviour calling to us and leading us to eternal life. His voice is the only one that can give us true and lasting happiness. His voice is the only one that can truly lead us to salvation. As we go throughout this week, we ask the Lord to help us to truly listen for his voice, so that we might follow him more faithfully.

On this Good Shepherd Sunday, the Church also marks the World Day of Prayer for Vocations. On this day, we fulfill the Lord's instruction to "Pray the Lord of the harvest to send laborers into his harvest" (Mt 9:38; Lk 10:2). On this day, we pray that young men and women hear and respond generously to the Lord's call to the priesthood, diaconate, religious life, societies of apostolic life or secular institutes. In our Diocese, Bishop Fabbro has also called for a Year of Prayer for Vocations to the Priesthood, which begins on Pentecost Sunday 2023, and continues until Pentecost Sunday 2024. In this year, we pray specifically for Vocations to the Priesthood in our own local Church. More information about this year of prayer will be released in the coming weeks.

Remember also that the work of promoting Vocations is a work that all of us are called to. If you think you know someone who may have a calling to serve the Lord in some capacity, don't be afraid to tell them. Your voice may be the seed planted in that person's life that enables them to truly hear God's call to service!


