From the Pastor's Desk...

During this Lent we have been looking at "Attitude Adjustment", about the virtue of humility. We've seen how humility is, in essence, an honest appraisal of ourselves. We are complex creatures, made in God's image and likeness, yet at the same time flawed, weak, and sinful. Listening helps us grow in humility. We recognize our littleness when we turn to God in prayer. We are humble when we refrain from comparing ourselves to others, but rather measure our own growth. We are humble when we own up to our sins, and when we forgive those who have wronged us. And this weekend we are reminded that sometimes we are humbled because we're caught—yet Jesus is always there to forgive.

Since my arrival here at Assumption I have been in awe at this amazing parish. I've learned that when I listen to you and get out of your way incredible things happen. Despite our lack of parking and other amenities, we continue to grow in an age when the Church is losing members. We have many announcements at each Mass because there are so many things going on. The pastoral team is without parallel. All of you make me look good; yet I am humbled, because I know it is *you* who are the ones who are responsible for that.

And now it looks like more is in store for each of us. When Paul Mullins introduced himself to me at the outdoor Mass for the Solemnity of the Assumption in 2017, I could never have imagined we would reach the point where we are now. Because of his indefatigable work, we have learned so much about our recent history, and what transpired during the failed fundraising campaigns. And in our humble admission of our errors, new life is being born. The diocesan building commission was enthusiastic in their support for us proceeding with restoration work as funds become available. Much remains to be decided; we are embarking on an adventure. I encourage you to read my letter to the parishioners enclosed with this bulletin, and to pray for Our Lady's intercession and the guidance of the Holy Spirit.

It will take place on the school grounds. If you are not able to walk, you are invited to stay in the gym in the prayerful space we have to offer.


