From the Administrator's Desk...

This weekend's Gospel is a powerful passage to meditate on, because there is a lot that takes place in only a few verses. If we immerse ourselves into the story, we can see the Apostles struggling to guide the boat as it is continually battered and beaten by the wind and waves. We can sense the terror the Apostles felt when they saw the mysterious figure coming towards them across the water. We see Peter's faith in Jesus, as without hesitation, he heeds the command to come to Jesus on the water. We also see what happens when Peter takes his eyes off Jesus, allowing the fear of the storm to once again overtake him.

At its core, today's Gospel is a lesson on the importance of faith in our lives. The Gospel challenges us to ask ourselves if we are able to hear the voice of Jesus calling to us in the midst of the storms of our lives. It reminds us to work to strengthen our faith, so that in the midst of those storms, we can be aware of God's call to us to come to him. It also challenges us to not allow ourselves to be overcome by fear, or to lose sight of Jesus in the midst of life's trials.

In the midst of the storms of our life, it can be easy for us to lose sight of God's presence in our lives, and to doubt his care and concern for his people. This Gospel reminds us that he is always with us, and will always respond to our cries for help, even in those moments where we have lost sight of him. It also reminds us that Jesus can calm the storms that we face in our lives. Even though we may not realize the full calming of those storms until we are fully united with God in the Kingdom of Heaven, The Gospel gives us an invitation to place our hope and trust in God's promises.

I want to take a moment to thank all the volunteers who worked to make the Parish Picnic at St. Alphonsus such a success. Special thanks goes out to the Knights of Columbus from the Archbishop Dennis O'Connor Council, and the members of the St. Alphonsus Conference of the Society of St. Vincent de Paul. It was wonderful to be able to gather together for food and fellowship!

I would like to extend an invitation to attend the St. Angela Festival this weekend at St. Angela Merici Church. More information can be found on the Parish website. I also want to wish the Parishioners at Assumption a Happy Feast Day, as we prepare to celebrate the Solemnity of the Assumption on August 15. May Our Lady intercede for us all, and lead us closer to her Son.




