From the Administrator's Desk...

In the week following our celebration of Christmas, the Church celebrates two important feasts: the Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph, and the Solemnity of Mary, the Holy Mother of God.

Both of these Feasts teach us important lessons about our faith. As we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Family, we recognize the importance of Christian families. The Family is known as the Domestic Church, where the majority of instruction in the ways of the Faith is meant to take place. The Holy Family is meant to be a model for us all, and to teach us the importance of family life in the home.

Although we do not know much about the life of the Holy Family, apart from a couple of accounts in Luke's Gospel, we do know that their life was fairly ordinary relative to the standards of the day. They faced their share of difficulties, some of which are recorded in Scripture. Pope Francis reminds us that "In families, there are difficulties, but these difficulties are overcome with love. Hate doesn't overcome any difficulty. Division of hearts doesn't overcome any difficulty. Only love is capable of overcoming difficulties." This love can reign supreme, even when the circumstances of one's family life are not ideal, or when one is faced with the reality of broken relationships and broken families. Love can pull the pieces together, and help the members of the family to find healing in the midst of heartache.

The Solemnity of Mary, the Mother of God, recognizes that Jesus is both fully human and fully divine. It is a response to a false belief in the early Church that Mary was only the mother of Jesus' humanity, not of his Divinity. The Council of Ephesus, which was convened in 431, rejected this teaching, and gave Mary the title of "Theotokos", a Greek word meaning "God-bearer". It is from this word that we derive the title "Mother of God".

Mary is known as the God-bearer because she gave birth to Jesus, the Son of God. Each of us are also called to be God-bearers, and to bring Jesus to those that we encounter in our daily lives. As we celebrate the World Day for Peace on January 1, we recognize that it is the Peace of Christ that the world desperately needs to receive, if we are going to bring an end to the violence and destruction that is tearing our world apart. How can you bear God into situations of division and discord, and help to bring peace where there is strife?

On behalf of our Family of Parishes staff, I want to wish you all a Happy and Blessed New year. May God's blessings be yours in 2024!




