JUBILEE 2025 FAITH RESOURCES

On December 12th we celebrate the feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe as well as the Day of Prayer in Solidarity with Indigenous Peoples. The resources this week help us understand the feast and day of prayer. Advent wreath candle lighting resource for week two as well as a way of praying to find God in the everyday.

- **Prayers for Lighting the Advent Wreath Candles:** This resource provides a simple prayer service for each week in Advent for families to light the Advent candles.
- **Our Lady of Guadalupe Explained:** This resource from the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe presents the story of the feast, a description of the symbolism on the image of Mary and a message from the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops on the day of Prayer.
- **Remembering the Bridge to Be Built Between Us.** This resource from the Diocese of Gatineau reflects on the feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe and connects it to the National Day of Prayer in Solidarity with Indigenous Peoples.
- **Advent Examen:** This Jesuit resource describes the examen way of praying and then gives an examen to use during the Advent season. The exam prayer invites us to look over our day and see where God has been present and where we have failed to see God's presence.
