Every time I start to write, all that I can think of are the many times that I have been overwhelmed by the support that I have received from the Parishioners here at Assumption as I began my Priestly Ministry. I am also awestruck by the many ways in which God has been at work in my life. I wondered how I would know what to say when faced with grieving families, or when celebrating the Sacrament of Reconciliation. I quickly found, however, that the Holy Spirit, which is conferred in a powerful way upon the Priest in the Sacrament of Holy Orders, is indeed powerfully at work in the life of a Priest. When I cannot find the words to say, I am constantly amazed by the way in which the Holy Spirit speaks through me, and guides me to find the right words to say. The experience of Priesthood has been far beyond what I ever could have imagined it to be. New things about my life as a Priest are revealed to me by the Spirit each and every day- and that revelation helps me to recognize that I am still learning: still seeking to grow in my own service of God, and striving always to become a holier Priest each and every day of my life.
