Jeremiah 1:419; Ps. 70; 1 Cor. 13:4-13; Luke 4: 21-30

We admire prophets—until they make demands on us. We are mistaken if we think we can worship the Son of God, but reject the demands of Jesus's word. Jesus's experience in his hometown of Nazareth prepared him for his destiny of rejection and death. Even now most of us prefer to turn a deaf ear to those who disturb our conscience rather than accept the message spoken by today's prophets. The first reading recounts God's choice of Jeremiah to speak his word and God's promise of strength when people reject him. Prophets must not be afraid, but turn to God in their difficulties. St. Paul's hymn to charity challenges every prophet as well as those disturbed by them.

The apostle insists that every spiritual gift, including prophecy, must be governed by agape, selfless love. Without this highest gift of all; every other gift of grace is worthless. When everything else has passed away, charity endures. The way of selfless love is beyond human achievement, but Jesus' death, which pours out on us this gift of selfless love, is present to us at every Eucharist.
