## From The Administrators Desk . . .

This weekend, the Church celebrates the World Day of Prayer for Consecrated Life. On this day, we pray for all consecrated men and women religious, who carry out roles of service to the Church. Consecrated religious life is a special Christian lifestyle—a special way of holiness—marked by publicly professing vows of poverty, chastity, and obedience, and living them as a sign of the in-breaking Kingdom of God.

For most Catholics, the religious institute, or religious community, is the most familiar form of consecrated life. In addition to the elements common to all consecrated life, religious life requires those who have professed vows in a community to live the common life, sharing all they possess and engaging in the common apostolic works of their religious community. The Church recognizes many religious institutes, commonly called religious orders, congregations, or societies. A religious man may be a monk, friar, or brother, and may or may not be ordained as a priest. A religious woman may be a cloistered nun or an active sister.

Consecrated life can take other forms as well. There are secular institutes, whose members do not share a common life, but instead seek to evangelize the world by bringing Christ into the many different places where they work. There are also societies of apostolic life, which do not profess vows, but instead unite themselves to serve a common purpose. All of these forms of consecrated life share a common goal, which is to be a light in the world, and to reflect the light of Christ to all peoples.

In our Family of Parishes, we have been blessed to have the presence of many religious communities over the years. The Sisters of the Holy Names of Jesus and Mary have served in Windsor since 1864. The Basilian Fathers have served at Assumption Church, and in various other ministries in Windsor since 1870. The Scalabrinian Fathers served the Italian community in Windsor for many years. Windsor is also blessed with the presence of other religious congregations, including the Ursuline Sisters, the Sisters of St. Joseph, the Franciscans, and other communities throughout our Diocese.

As we hear in our readings this weekend, the Lord calls all of us to serve him in various ways, just as he called his first disciples on the shores of the Lake of Gennesaret. This week, I invite you to pray for all of those who have responded to the call to enter consecrated life, that the Lord will strengthen them in their roles of service to the people of God.
