## *From the Administrator's Desk...*

One of the things that consistently amazes me about the Liturgical Cycle of the Church is how seamlessly the different seasons flow together. When we consider our readings for this Sunday, we see several of the same themes that were present in our readings for the Epiphany last Sunday. We see a reminder of our call to be a light to the nations in our first reading from the prophet Isaiah. Our Gospel continues the theme of Jesus being revealed to the disciples, through the testimony of John the Baptist.

This “interconnectedness” of the liturgical seasons reminds us that we are on a continual journey towards the Kingdom of Heaven, and towards greater union with God. Even though we call this season “Ordinary Time,” there is nothing ordinary about our journey of faith! The name of this season does not mean that it is a boring time in our Church calendar, or that it is somehow less special than the seasons of Advent and Christmas, which we have just celebrated. In this case, the term “Ordinary” comes from “Ordinal”, referring to the fact that the Sundays are numbered throughout the course of the year, outside of the seasons of Advent, Christmas, Lent, and Easter.

As we enter this period of Ordinary Time between Christmas and Lent, we are called to focus on how the birth of Christ has changed our lives. We are reminded of our call to journey with Christ, and to strive to carry out his will in all things. We are called to seek the guidance of the Holy Spirit, who reveals Jesus to us, just as the Spirit revealed Jesus to John the Baptist.

Our challenge, as we journey through this period, is to recognize that God doesn't just come to us in the great and powerful moments. We are called to recognize his presence in the day-to-day tasks of our lives, be that work, school, caring for family members, or doing tasks around the house. His presence does not lessen, simply because we are not doing “extraordinary” or “special” things. The more that we can learn to appreciate our church's liturgical cycle, the more we can begin to apply its rhythm to our lives. Doing so helps us to live our faith more fully.

My prayer is that this period of Ordinary Time will be a time of grace for us all, that will help us to prepare for the coming Lenten season. May we all become more aware of God's presence in our lives and give thanks to God for all his gifts and blessings.
