Deut. 18:15-20; 1 Cor. 7:32-35; Mk. 1:21-28



In today's gospel the demons recognize the authority in the voice of Jesus. They know who he is, but the people around him do not. They acknowledge his power over them, but again and again Jesus

finds himself in conflict with the crowds and with their leaders over the question of his authority. How can this be, since he has the credentials of the true prophet as described by Moses in our first reading today? In fact, he exercises the very authority of God. Failure of comprehend Jesus' true identity probably stems from mistaken expectations. We may be able to admit that we want and need a saviour, but we may not always grasp the implications of this desire. Little by little light will be thrown on the person of Jesus during the coming weeks.
