Family and Youth Ministry News

FAMILY REFLECTION - AND - ACTION! Hello families. It is the prayer here that you are all well in our Lord. The Gospel this weekend shares the story of the Good Samaritan. Take a look at Luke 10:25-37 and read with family. What are the key ideas that Jesus is sharing about the Good Samaritan? (Inclusion, acceptance, care for others). Take a minute and think about what it must feel like to not be included (in groups, at school, on teams, etc.). "Excluding" others in some ways is a form of bullying (even adults are subject to this from time to time). As a family consider someone who seems to be excluded from society. Perhaps "adopt" a neighbour, senior, or someone you know is lonely and isolated. As a family make cards, bake cookies and visit that individual. **Finish prayer time with an Act of Contrition asking forgiveness for neglecting or ignoring others.** Don't be shy, take that "action" today!

GET READY! GET SET! - VOLUNTEER (...?) Summer is *not* a quiet time for Family Ministry as all of the events from Sacramental prep to outreach and ministry to the schools happens "all of a sudden" in September and continues straight through to December is planned, booked and developed. Family Ministry at Windsor Heritage Catholic Family of Parishes serves the 5 parish communities offering Sacramental prep for First Communion, First Reconciliation and Confirmation, as well as, ministry to 5 schools (4 Elementary and Assumption High School). ***This year we are hoping to outreach with a Vocations Event at the high school, the Annual Christmas Party, movies, Trunk or Treat, Advent Family Workshop and an Advent Christmas Caroling (a "All Things Catholic Girl" event is under consideration also). All of this ministry cannot happen without YOUR help.*** I recently spoke with a parishioner who though advanced in years wanted to help in some way. I asked if they could spare an hour to sit in on a Confirmation lesson (so that there is a Safe Environment compliment of adults present). I will even supply a coffee or tea if you like! She smiled and said she would consider it. ***That is all this ministry needs.*** Volunteering in past has meant giving over one's time to a commitment that they could not keep up with. As Pastoral Minister of Family and Youth I suggest that you look at it as an ***opportunity to serve Jesus - just one time - for about an hour.*** In the Gospel of Matthew 26:40 Jesus asks: ***"Couldn't you stay awake with me for one hour?"***.
