Jer. 23: 1-6; Ps. 22; Eph. 2:13-18; Mark 6:30-34



People are hungry for the saving word of God! In Mark's gospel it is the crowds who are quicker than Jesus' disciples or relatives to understand him. the disciples had just served their apprenticeship as apostles, those who are sent. They were tired after their first experience of ministry, and Jesus suggested that they rest. But their master's concern for his new co-workers soon gave way to compassion for the shepherdless crowd. In the first reading, God threatens the careless pastors of his people, promising to send good shepherds and, finally, the messiah who will be both shepherd and ruler. The letter to the Ephesians reminds us that Christ is the principle of unity in a world torn by enmities. As his followers, we must not be intolerant or retreat into a ghetto Christianity. Jesus brings what the world is longing for, peace and unity. We are the apostles of the one who unites. Through Jesus in the Spirit all people will come to the Father.

Dear Parishioners,

I do want to update you on the situation concerning the restoration of our Church. As you know, we gave notice to PMC (the Fundraiser) in February of our intention to end the contract effective June 19. On that date, The Corporate Board of the Assumption Heritage Trust Fund made the decision to resign with the exception of Fr. Tom Rosica, and of course, Bishop Fabbro. The Bishop will either appoint new members or dissolve AHTF. We await his decision on this matter. After a bit of delay, the AHTF files were turned over to the Diocese. We have made a first review and will now await the Diocese to name the firm to do the audit. When that is completed, I will meet with the Bishop and we will discuss the format for a parish information session. With this information, we then can map out a direction for the Restoration Project to continue. I fully understand that the parishioners are becoming anxious and were hoping for more detailed information sooner. I can assure you that the steps the Bishop has taken are in our best interest and we will be moving forward on very solid ground. Our parish and this church are under the protection of the Virgin Mary, as she has guided us for generations. I am most confident of her continued protection and care.

We continue to welcome to our community the former parishioners of Blessed Sacrament Church as well as the 9 am worshipping community of Holy Name. If there is anything we can do to make you feel welcome and included, please let any of the staff know.

You will be commissioned on the weekend of Saturday, August 4th, or Sunday August 5th, at the Mass you attend. The workshops will also explain how this will happen. 
