FAMILY REFLECTION: "This week's Gospel from Luke speaks of the transfiguration of Jesus in the presence of Peter, John, and James. *"In the Family Connection this week, the voice from heaven speaks to the disciples saying, "Listen to him." The Transfiguration was a focused moment for the disciples when they heard God speaking to them and experienced Jesus in glory."* Listening is always a challenge for many of us - especially within families. Take a moment when everyone is home and about their own business. Stop. Listen to how much "noise" is being made. TV, radio, appliances in kitchen, computer, toys. Gather the family and turn everything **off**. Pretty quiet, isn't it? Even if we use headphones to "quiet" the atmosphere, one can "tune out" the real and important relationships around us. *How can we "quiet" ourselves to hear what God is saying to us? How can we as family "Listen to him" - "Listen to Jesus" through this holy season?* Perhaps have a quiet time, a period of time a couple of times per week during Lent, where the family "quiets" has prayer and quiet activities - in order to listen better to each other and especially what Jesus is saying to us. Spend a few such moments as a family, asking God to help you listen well to one another and to Jesus." (*Sourced partially from Loyola Press*).
