SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT

March 4th, 2012

Genesis 22:1-18; Romans 8:31-37; Mark 9:2-10

In today's gospel of the Transfiguration, the message the disciples receive from the Father in an enveloping cloud is: "This is my beloved Son, Listen to him." Those heroes and guides of the past from Abraham on, those whose lives anticipated the fulfillment of God's blessings, now fade into the background. There is no one but Jesus. Our submission of faith is to him alone. We bind ourselves to him even if that means going to Jerusalem and witnessing his pas-

sion. Moreover, as St. Paul reminds us, we bind ourselves to him in the midst of our own tribulations. And we do so knowing that he has also irrevocably bound himself to us. The Transfiguration offers striking insight into Christ's authority, mission and nature. The journey begins and ends with Jesus.



Dear Parishioners: as we now enter more and more into the journey of Lent, I want to point out the many activities and services of our parish during these gracefilled days. Daily Mass at Assumption Church Mon.-Fri. is at 8 am and 12:10 pm; Sat. at 8 am. Holy Name of Mary Thursday Mass at 8:30 am. Stations of the Cross and Benediction each Friday in Assumption Church at 7 pm. The Diocesan Day of Reconciliation will be held on Wed. March 21. We will also be celebrating the Sacrament of the Sick at all weekend Masses on March 17/18. And finally, a financial update will be given to the parish the weekend of March 24/24 (This is a Lenten exercise to make us aware of our almsgiving throughout the year). The Holy Week schedule will be included in our bulletin in the next few weeks. Of course, adoration continues in Holy Rosary Chapel on a weekly basis offering all in Windsor a haven of peace for prayer. Let us continue to follow him to Jerusalem and as St. Paul tells us: if we are faithful in following him in his cross, surely we will rejoice with him in his resurrection.


