# Fifth Sunday of Easter—May 19th, 2019

## From the Pastor's Desk...

During this Easter season we've been considering how Jesus' resurrection from the dead and the faith that it engendered were *groundbreaking* events. For me, the challenge is to maintain the faith and zeal that characterized the early Church. We saw how the disciples were agents of healing, and considered how we, too, can heal others with our presence, our words, our actions. We learned how the apostles were convinced that they had to obey God rather than human beings. And then on Good Shepherd Sunday the readings reminded us that we are all called to be *evangelizers*, bearers of the *good news* to the wider community. Today we learn that there is a need for sacrifice: Sometimes there are difficulties in proclaiming God's presence, especially in a world that is not ready to hear the message. Yet we come from a community of faith that strengthens us, and we are called to return always to that community. Since arriving here, one of my priorities and that of our entire parish team has been to work towards a strengthening of our parish community. We come from so many different backgrounds: we have different parishes of origin, different ethnic backgrounds, different places of birth. We speak different languages in our homes. We are from different economic and social strata; we have varied interests, varying tastes in food and culture. We have different political views, and even different views of how the Church should be. Yet, we are all one family, one parish.

As we move into the *groundbreaking* phase of the restoration of Assumption church we will all be called upon to make sacrifices of one sort or another, whether it be losing a familiar church home, or financial, or any other kind. And it will be our duty to strengthen the souls of the disciples and encourage them to continue in the faith, to paraphrase Luke in this weekend's first reading. We will have whatever strength we need when we, just as Paul and Barnabas did, continue to return to the Church community and share the wonders that God is working through us. And whether you've realized it or not, God is indeed working wonders through us, and other people are recognizing it! The Diocese of London has enlisted your pastoral team to facilitate a workshop at the Diocesan Study Days called "Reigniting the Fire", on bringing the parish back to life. Please keep us in your prayer.

On another note, some of you have asked if there was a way to listen to the interview CBC radio did with Patrick McMahon and me about the movie "Prey". We have placed a link on the parish website; just click on it and you can listen.
