# Third Sunday of Easter—May 5th, 2019

## From the Pastor's Desk...

"We must obey God rather than human beings." That sentence, taken from this weekend's first reading, haunts me in so many ways. On the surface it sounds so nice, so logical: Of course, if I believe in God, who is all good and always has my best interests at heart, I will choose to obey God rather than a flawed, sinful human person. The reality, though, is that there are so many unknowns. How do I know what it is that God wants me to do? How can I be sure? What if I am totally mistaken? And I have to live with people; if I go against what my loved ones want me to do, I have to suffer the consequences. These are real dilemmas.

The early Church often found itself in the midst of these dilemmas. The first believers were all good Jews, and their belief in Jesus as the Risen Lord just meant the fulfillment of their hopes, not a departure from their religion. Thus, the commands of the Sanhedrin would have been taken seriously. In a way, it would be akin to an order from the bishop, if not from the pope himself. Yet they chose to continue proclaiming the message of Jesus' resurrection because it was such a *groundbreaking* event. The resurrection of Jesus, and its implications, trumps everything else—so much so that "they rejoiced that they were considered worthy to suffer dishonour for the sake of the name." Wow! I think of my own tentative steps of obeying God instead of my own comfort level. I keep looking for reassurances. Last weekend I mentioned in my homily that I saw the documentary film "Prey", about abuse victims of Hod Marshall, and how I saw that my reaching out to Patrick, one of the victims, had been a moment of healing for him. Even though I had not been "commanded by human beings" not to reach out to him, my insides were screaming out to me to stay in my comfort zone. That day, though, I think I heard God's call to step out and to share in his pain. It was indeed groundbreaking for me.

This weekend's gospel passage is a reminder to me that Jesus wants me to love him above all else, and to feed his lambs, tend his sheep. That will often challenge me to move out of my comfort zone, to boldly preach God's infinite love and mercy with everything I say and do. With the strength of my faith community, I can do it. How about you?
