**WORLD DAY OF THE POOR** In 2017, Pope Francis established the World Day of the Poor, when the Church sets aside a Sunday every year to "reflect on how poverty is at the very heart of the Gospel". It is celebrated on the 33rd Sunday in Ordinary Time which falls on November 16<sup>th</sup> this year. The resources for today share Pope Leo's reflections on the day and Catholic Social Teaching on our Option for the Poor.

**FAMILY REFLECTION:** This Sunday's teaching is about being prepared for Jesus' return by living a good, kind, and helpful life every day. While we don't know when Jesus will come back, we can be ready by following his teachings and using the talents God has given us to help others, just like the servants who used their gifts wisely in the story. Share with children - Be Ready: Jesus is coming back one day, but no one knows when, so we should be ready at all times by being loving and kind.

Follow Jesus' Example: The best way to be prepared is to live like Jesus did—by being a good friend, helping others, and praying. Use Your Talents: God has given each of us special talents and gifts. We should use them to help others instead of hiding or burying them. Trust in God: Life can have difficulties, but we can trust in God to be with us and help us through them. Activity idea: Ask children to share one thing they are good at or enjoy doing. Help them brainstorm how they can use that talent to help someone this week. For example, a child who likes to draw could draw a picture for a grandparent, or a child who is a good listener could listen to a sibling who is upset. Sourced partially: Loyola Press.
