As we prepare to celebrate Christmas we are well served to take time to reflect on Jesus' words, to invite him to prepare our hearts to receive him more fully in the Eucharist, and to meet him when he comes at the end of time. May this Advent season be a time of joyful preparation for the coming of the Lord.

As we begin the month of December, I want to publicly thank Rosetta Dipronio for serving as our temporary receptionist for the past three months.
