JUBILEE 2025 FAITH RESOURCES

Advent begins this weekend as we celebrate the First Sunday of Advent. The resources this week are focused on Advent and ways to help us celebrate the season and prepare for Christmas.

- **Advent Calendar. Daily at Home Advent Activities for Families:** This resource from Sadlier Religion, offers a family activity suggestion for every day of Advent.
- **Advent and the Liturgical Year:** This resource presents a look at the liturgical year which begins with the first Sunday of Advent.
- **Blessing of the Advent Wreath:** This resource from the United States Catholic Conference of Bishops, provides families with a simple blessing of the Advent wreath.
- **Prayers for Lighting the Advent Wreath Candles:** This resource provides a simple prayer service for each week in Advent for families to light the Advent candles.

Family Ministry News

FIRST WEEKEND OF ADVENT : In families there is building excitement as the Advent Season nears. "Are you ready yet?" is a common conversation among adults. Of course the stores have been stocked with cards, gifts, decorations and novelties for a month now - *but how do we as Catholic families "ready" ourselves for the Incarnation of Jesus Christ at Christmas?* Many of us feel the pressure early in the holiday season to be ready for Christmas. But today's Gospel challenges us to be ready for something other than the gift-giving of Christmas. Read together today's Gospel reading. (Matthew 24:37-44) *As a family, talk about what it means to be ready for the day of the Lord.* One of the roles of the family, the domestic church, is to be a school of faith leading one another to salvation. Reflect together as a family on how your family helps one another to be better Christians. Commit to one thing that your family will do this Advent season to help one another be better Christians. You might choose to write this commitment down and post it in a prominent place in your home, perhaps near your family's Advent wreath. Pray together that God will help you in this Advent commitment. Pray together the Lord's Prayer (*Sourced partially from Loyola Press*).

AS FAMILY: Making a paper chain to decorate the Christmas tree is an easy way to help the family "wait" for Christmas Day. If you have green and red or purple and pink (though any colour will do) construction paper cut 30 strips that can be taped together in a chain. Starting this weekend write down a prayer or the name of someone you want to pray for or any intention that the family may have at this time on a strip and tape into a loop. Do this daily "taping" the loops together building one by one. On Christmas Eve drape the chain on your tree or decorate the house with it - remembering all the people and intentions you prayed for this holy season.
