### **Remembrance Day**


On Tuesday November 11th, all Canadians will pause to observe Remembrance Day, which has become a treasured annual tradition.

This year, the observance has a particular poignancy, not only commemorating the 100th anniversary of the start of the Great War of 1914-18 but also coming so soon after the recent violent deaths of two dedicated members of the Canadian Forces, Warrant Officer Patrice Vincent and Corporal Nathan Cirillo -- the latter as he stood ceremonial guard at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier at the National War Memorial in Ottawa. As we remember and pray for not only these two men but also the many thousands of our fellow Canadians who have died or suffered grievous physical and mental harm in war, let us not forget that in recalling their sacrifices on our behalf, we are also renewing our own commitment to work to build a world of justice and peace, a world from which the horror of war has been eradicated once and or all time.


