# From The Pastors Desk...

Happy birthday! We're old. 250 years is a long time, especially in this continent. I knew a bit about Assumption before I came here, since I used to come for the occasional visit when I lived just across the river at Ste. Anne's in Detroit. Nothing, though, could have prepared me for my experience here. As Patrick Brode wrote in the introduction for 250 Years of Assumption Parish, "so central was Assumption to the province's spiritual origins that historian Michael Power concluded, 'the history of the faith in Southwestern Ontario was the history of its development in Our Lady of the Assumption Parish."" That is certainly something to celebrate.

Yet as important as our history is, we also celebrate the parish as it is today. As time went on from those early days, parish after parish was carved out of what had been one. Today, with the reality of the Church in the early twenty-first century, parishes are being merged, and Assumption now consists of what had become four parishes: Assumption, Blessed Sacrament, Holy Name of Mary, and Saint Patrick. And as we look to the future and our association with Saint Alphonsus and Saint Angela parishes as part of one family, we have even more adventures ahead of us.

The gospel passage that the Church gives us as we celebrate our sestercentennial is a great challenge to me, and I hope it is to you as well. In the parable about the two sons we hear that it is not what we say, but what we do that is important. Thus, we are called to discern God's will for our parish and then take action to put that into practice. I am certain that we are up for the task! Assumption is a vibrant community of faith, which to paraphrase Michael Power's words, is still contributing to the history of the faith in Southwestern Ontario. We continue to be an important presence in West Windsor, reaching out to Catholics and people of all faiths or none. I am convinced that this community will continue to be important to Windsor for many years to come. I am deeply grateful that you have welcomed me into your lives and hearts. ### <u>The 1<sup>st</sup> step of RCIA:</u> <u>Period of Evangelization and Precatechumenate</u>

During this time prior to the beginning of the RCIA process, "inquirers" who are attracted in some way to the Catholic Church express their interests and begin a formation process of learning and growing in the Catholic faith. How long this lasts depends on the individuals. After discernment and consultation, those seeking baptism may seek acceptance into the Order of Catechumens, through the Rite of Acceptance. The inquirer states their desire for baptism amidst the parish community. The parish assembly affirms this desire and the inquirer becomes a Catechumen. Other baptized Christians seeking full communion with the Catholic church are encouraged to share in the formation sessions of the RCIA with the Catechumens. At this time Assumption parish is welcoming inquirers, as well as the time and gifts of parishioners who will prayerfully walk with those seeking initiation into our faith. Please consider being a sponsor or catechist, or a prayer companion for those on this journey.
