From the Administrator's Desk...

Today's readings remind us of the importance of making good choices in our life of faith. Like many things in the Gospel, the parable that Jesus tells today causes us to think a little bit. We must "read between the lines" to understand what Jesus is saying, and the point he is trying to make. Jesus is reminding us through this parable that it is not enough to just pay lip service to the Gospel and the Commandments: we need to actually live by them!

The Parable that we hear today challenges us to remember that our words are meaningless if they are not followed up with good action. It's very similar to what St. Paul expresses in his teaching on love in the First Letter to the Corinthians. St. Paul reminds us that without love, our words, however eloquent they may be, are just like a noisy gong or a clanging cymbal. Even our knowledge and faith are meaningless if they are not motivated by a genuine love for others, and a genuine desire to do what is right.

This is precisely why Jesus tells the Pharisees and scribes that the tax collectors and prostitutes will enter heaven before they do. Even though the people that the Pharisees labeled as grave sinners did wrong in the past, they have learned from the error of their ways, through their encounter with the love and mercy of God. Thanks to that encounter, they are now striving to do the right thing and be con-

The Pharisees and scribes, on the other hand, are so rooted in their selfrighteousness and pride that they cannot possibly begin to show love to those they have labeled as sinners. They continue to look down on them and make judgments about them: all the while failing to see how in doing so, they are not keeping the commandment to "love your neighbour as yourself."

If we want to find the remedy to this situation, when faced with similar situations in our life, we can look to the example of Jesus, which St. Paul so beautifully lays out in our Second Reading today. He reminds us how Jesus, during his ministry on earth, did not Lord his Divinity over us, but humbled himself to be like us in all things but sin. It is because of this humbling that Jesus was exalted far above all others. God desires to do the same for us as well. My prayer is that all of us can learn to turn away from sinful pride and be humbled in the sight of the Lord, so that the Lord may raise us up on high.


